## **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

**\*\*UPDATE\*\* - A 14 year-old juvenile has been charged with 5 counts of Wanton Endangerment - 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and 1 count of Possession of a Handgun by a Minor - 1<sup>st</sup> Offense. Detectives obtained information on the suspect after conducting interviews with the victims. Based upon this information, detectives were able to locate this juvenile within a few hours. Two handguns were located in the juveniles possession, one of which is consistent with the weapon used during the commission of this crime. This juvenile was taken into custody and is lodged at the Warren Regional Juvenile Detention Center.**

On Saturday, March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at approximately 4:06 am, the Owensboro Police Department responded to the 3000 block of Allen Street for a reported firearm discharge. Two occupied residences were both struck by gunfire. No one was injured.
