## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

\*\*UPDATE\*\* - This case was presented to the Daviess County Grand Jury on August 3, 2022 after a lengthy investigation by Owensboro Police Department Detectives. During the investigation, Detectives traveled to and coordinated with agencies in Kentucky, Illinois and Alabama in an effort to identify the suspects. Based upon the evidence gathered during the investigation, the Daviess County Grand Jury indicted Derrick Carroll (29 years old of Owensboro) and Damian M. Fields (27 years old of Owensboro) in this case.

Damian M. Fields is currently in custody at the Daviess County Detention Center for other offenses. Derrick Carroll is currently in custody in Alabama for other offenses and state extradition is being pursued.

**Derrick Carroll was indicted for:** 

• Murder

Damian M. Fields was indicted for:

• Murder

These indictments are the result of hundreds of hours of investigation by OPD Detectives, dozens of search warrants, and multiple tips provided by members of the community.

Additionally, assistance provided by Mclean County Sheriff's Office, Richland County Sheriff's Office (Illinois), Peoria Police Department (Illinois), Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (AL State Police), Limestone County Sheriff's Office (Alabama), Priceville Police Department (Alabama), Decatur Police Department (Alabama), Kentucky Commonwealth Attorney's Office, Regional Organized Crime Information Center (ROCIC), and Kentucky Regional Computer Forensics Laboratory were instrumental during portions of this investigation.

On Monday June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at approximately 11:08 pm, the Owensboro Police Department responded to the 1200 Block of West 7<sup>th</sup> Street for a possible vehicle collision with injuries where a building had been struck. When officers arrived, a bystander was performing CPR on an adult male who had been driving the vehicle. As officers began assisting with medical care, they discovered a single gunshot wound on the driver. The victim was transported to Owensboro Health Regional Hospital via ambulance where he later died from his injuries.

Detectives responded to investigate and believe the victim was shot in the 900 block of West 7<sup>th</sup> Street. After being shot he attempted to drive away before striking a residence.
