Two Juveniles and One Adult were Charged by Detectives with Multiple Acts of Property Damage.

On December 2, 2022 detectives from the Owensboro Police Department, using a variety of investigative techniques, located and charged two juveniles and one adult in connection with this crime spree that occurred on the evening of November 28, 2022.

Terry Geary (20 years old of Owensboro) has been charged with the below offenses and lodged at the Daviess County Detention Center:

- Criminal Mischief 1st Degree (10 counts)
- Criminal Mischief 2nd Degree (2 counts)
- Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree (1 count)
- Unlawful Transaction with a Minor 2nd Degree (3 counts)

Juvenile # 1 (17 years old at the time of the offenses of Daviess County) has been charged and lodged with the below offenses:

- Criminal Mischief 1st Degree (10 counts)
- Criminal Mischief 2nd Degree (2 counts)
- Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree (1 count)

Juvenile # 2 (16 years old of Owensboro) has been charged and lodged with the below offenses:

- Criminal Mischief 1st Degree (10 counts)
- Criminal Mischief 2nd Degree (2 counts)
- Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree (1 count)

Terry Geary has previously been charged with these offenses:

- Burglary 2nd Degree
- Receiving Stolen Property under \$500

Juvenile # 1 has previously been charged with these offenses:

- Terroristic Threatening 2nd Degree
- Harassment with Physical Contact

Juvenile # 2 has previously been charged with these offenses:

- Abuse of a Teacher Prohibited
- Assault 4th Degree (Domestic Violence)
- Theft by Unlawful Taking
- Terroristic Threatening 3rd Degree

Detectives are attempting to locate an additional individual who was involved in these crimes, and additional charges are expected.

OPD Detectives Investigating Multiple Reports of Property Damage.

Beginning at 8:30 pm on November 28, 2022, officers began receiving reports of damage caused to windows at multiple businesses and residences. The damage is consistent with being struck with a projectile from a bb or pellet gun. At this time, there have been approximately a dozen reports with the combined damage expected to be thousands of dollars. The majority of these reports occurred in the downtown area of Owensboro. The OPD Criminal Investigation's Division is currently investigating these crimes and believe that they are all related.

- 418 West 3rd Street (Rehabilitation & Performance Institute)
- 425 West 4th Street (Gipe Auto Color)
