Man Charged in String of Property Damages

UPDATE - The Owensboro Police Department's investigation resulted in obtaining limited video surveillance within city limits. Detectives followed up by canvassing areas outside the city limits where similar crimes occurred. As a result, they located video surveillance of a possible suspect vehicle which led detectives to an address in the 1800 Block of Reid Road where the vehicle was located.

Subsequently, the suspect was identified as Christopher Smithers and he was apprehended in the 5700 Block of Highway 144.

Detectives with the Owensboro Police Department contacted the Daviess County Sheriff's Office and provided them with information that may aid in their investigation of property damage incidents that occurred at addresses in the county.

The estimated damage to property for victims residing within the city was in excess of \$14,000.

After consulting with the Commonwealth's Attorney's Office, detectives charged Christopher Smithers (21 years old of Owensboro) with the following:

- Criminal Mischief 2nd Degree (9 Counts)
- Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree (40 Counts)

Smithers was arrested and lodged at the Daviess County Detention Center on an unrelated Failure to Appear warrant.

OPD Detectives Investigating Multiple Reports of Property Damage

Since April 6, 2023, at approximately 10:30 P.M., Officers from the Owensboro Police Department have responded to numerous reports of property damage. The damage is consistent with being struck with a projectile from a bb or pellet gun. At this time, there have been over 40 reports with the combined damage expected to be thousands of dollars. The Criminal Investigations Division is currently investigating all of these reports and believes that they are all related.
