Whitesville Man Charged with Robbery

On Saturday, January 20, 2024, at 7:54 P.M., Officers with the Owensboro Police Department responded to the 1000 Block of Burlew Boulevard in reference to a Robbery complaint. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the victim. Through the officer's investigation, it was determined that the initial robbery occurred at a residence in the 900 Block of Kentucky Parkway, where the victim was assaulted, and personal items were taken. The investigation revealed the victim was then forced into the suspect's vehicle where the assault continued and additional items were taken before the victim was able to get out of the vehicle.

Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division responded to the scene, interviewed the victim, and took over the investigation. Detectives were able to develop Landon Renfrow (32 years old of Whitesville) as a suspect. On Tuesday, February 6, 2024, Renfrow was brought to station for questioning, subsequently arrested, and transported to the Daviess County Detention Center on the following charges:
